Welcome to our newest members that have joined in these last few weeks, they have settled well and seem to be enjoying playing and making friends.


The children this week have been learning about Remembrance Day, and a volunteer has visited from Royal British Legion to collect our Poppy Tin collection and to thank us for our support!
